Day 1 (4th September 1939)

Evacuation by coach from school to Bushey Hall

Activities include: The 1940's Bed, The Evacuee's Suitcase, The 1939/40's lunch-box, Spy Catcher, Village Schoolroom

All meals normal (2019 style!)

Dinner

Evening activity – 1940s style game

Supper and bed

Day 2 (7th September 1942)

Breakfast - Ration Day begins!

Today's Menu will be 1940's style food

Activities include: The 1940s House, Dig for Victory Garden, The Militaria Display, The Woman's Land Army, The Air Raid Shelter & Personal stories from WW2.

Other details...



- Safety – self-contained accommodation, fire drill, staff on-site, groups supervised by an adult at all times.
- Kit list
 - no food except packed lunch for first day (1940s style if possible)
 - no electrical gadgets
 - 1940s clothing for Day 1
 - Comfortable clothing for activities on Days 2 & 3
 - Gas mask box & identity label made at school
 - Up to £5 to spend at the gift shop
- Must follow school rules or be collected by parents
- Medical forms & Dietary requirements
- Room arrangements – 10 bunk beds per room, boys and girls separate, all rooms (including staff) in same building
- No contact request



Departure & Return

- Coaches due to depart school at 9.15am
 - come to Laurel Room to sign in and hand in any medication and money
 - weather permitting, wait outside (or in the hall)
- Coaches due to depart Lincolnfield at 1.30pm/1.45pm
 - due back at school about 3pm (traffic allowing)
